

KNOW YOUR ELECTRICITY BILL



- 1 This is the month for which the bill is generated.
- 2 Consumer No. A unique number specific to a consumer which must be referred to while communicating with us.
- 3 This indicates the months (via 07181 indicates 07 for July and 18 for 2018 for which the bill is made. The last digit indicates the check digit of that particular month.
- 4 The date this bill has been generated.
- 5 Account details to pay the bill through RTGS/NEFT.
- 6 This is Consumer's Name & Address
- 7 Customer ID A unique number specific to a customer which must be referred to while communicating with us.
- 8 Tariff category of the Consumer.
- 9 This is the Gross Amount of the bill.
- 10 This indicates the Rebate given for Payment of the bill within due date. Consumers are requested to pay the bill within Due Date to avail of this facility.
- 11 This is the Due Date for this particular bill. Consumers are requested to pay the bill within Due Date to avail of the Rebate.
- 12 This the Net Amount payable of the bill.
- 13 This gives breakup of the Bill Amount.
- 14 This is the total Unit consumed during the period for which the bill has been raised.
- 15 Current Reading Date & Previous Reading Dates for this specified bill.
- 16 This gives the details of Last Payment made.
- 17 This diagram depicts the consumption for last 6 months with a comparison drawn with the similar months of the Previous Year.
- 18 This shows the various ways to Contact us.
- 19 This indicates the Sanctioned Load.
- 20 This indicates the Security Deposit held.

KNOW YOUR ELECTRICITY BILL



- 21 This gives details of Meter of the Consumer.
- 22 This is the address of the Consumer's Regional Office.
- 23 Details of bill calculation for the specific month.
- 24 The Rate table which indicates how the energy charge on the Units consumed is calculated.
- 25 This gives you details of your Customer Account Manager.
- 26 This shows details of lodging of Grievance with CESC.
- 27 This gives details of various modes of Payment available.
- 28 Details of our Cash Offices (with working hours) where Consumers can Pay their Electricity Bill by Cash/Cheque/DD.

Major Tariff Categories

* Domestic Tariff:

This tariff applies to supply of electricity for residential use.

Commercial tariff:

This tariff applies to supply of electricity at commercial establishments.

Industrial Tariff:

This tariff applies to supply of electricity for Industrial purposes.

The tariff rates vary and are applicable as per the Tariff Orders/ Regulations issued by the Hon'ble West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission from time to time
