A. GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

General Conditions mentioned hereunder are **mandatory** & must be complied with, to avoid rejection of the offer/s.

1. Experience in Coal sampling, sample preparation, and analysis of coal is essential for participation in the bidding process. Necessary credentials have to be submitted along with the bids.
2. **Sealed** offer to be submitted on or prior to the “Due Date”. Offers or Bids received after the “Due Date” shall be rejected without further reference.
3. All pages of the Tender/Bid comprising of Commercial Bid and Information/Documents as specified in Annexure III should be signed and seal affixed as a mark of acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Tender.
4. **EMD, Technical bid** and **Price Bid** shall be enclosed in three separate closed and sealed envelopes properly marked. These three envelopes shall be enclosed in one covering envelope containing the name of the Service Provider and Contact Details.
5. CESC Ltd. reserves the right to reject any or all of the Bids submitted in response to the Tender at any stage without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
6. **Validity:** All offers must remain valid for our acceptance/negotiation for 20 days after the Last Date of Submission.

9. CESC reserves the right to cancel/withdraw/modify this tender, partially or fully, without assigning any reason and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.
10. CESC reserves the right to negotiate with selected bidders (selected on the basis of Techno Commercial offer)
11. Any query / clarification regarding this Notice to be addressed to GM (Coal Management) in the email address cesc_fuelmanagement@rpsg.in latest by 17:00 Hrs of 23rd April, 2026 beyond which no query /clarification shall be entertained.

B. BIDDERS QUALIFYING CRITERIA (TECHNICAL BID):

To be considered for this NIT, bidders must meet the following criteria:

1. **Nationality of Bidders:** Only Indian National Companies, duly incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, or previous Companies Acts, are permitted to participate.



2. **MSME Norms Applicability:** Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME) norms, as per the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, will not be applicable to this specific NIT.
3. **Experience Requirement:** Only Bidder(s) with **demonstrated and relevant** experience in similar work shall be eligible to submit their offers.
4. **Joint Venture Prohibition:** Joint ventures are **strictly not permitted** to participate in this bidding process.
5. **Experience :** The bidder shall have a minimum experience of Coal sampling, sample preparation, and analysis of coal of 1.5 million Tonne per annum at loading end in any two of the last three financial years (incl FY 2025-26).
6. The bidder shall be empaneled in the list of 3rd party samplers finalized by CIL/ PFC / CEA. Certificate in support of the above have to be provided.
7. The bidder shall have **NABL accredited Labs** in or around Asansol / Dhanbad for carrying out the analysis work. Details of Labs with NABL accreditation certificates shall have to be provided in support of the above.
8. **Past Performance Record:** Any Bidder who has previously **failed to satisfactorily perform** any supply/service contract awarded by CESC Ltd or its Subsidiaries will not be permitted to participate in the Bidding Process, at the sole discretion of CESC.
9. **Affidavit of Non-Debarment/Non-Blacklisting:** Bidders are required to submit an affidavit from a 1st Class Judicial Magistrate, explicitly stating that they, or their wholly owned / majority subsidiary, are **not debarred or blacklisted** by CESC or any other customer at the time of submission of this bid.
10. **Financial Solvency and Net Worth:** The Bidder(s) must be solvent and not have been declared bankrupt. They shall possess a positive net worth of **INR Two (2) Crores** as on the bid submission date. A Certificate from the Statutory Auditors of the Bidder must be attached. The last two years' financial statements, including balance sheets, a summary of the last two years' turnover, Profit & Loss (P&L) statements, Gross Profit, and Profit After Tax (PAT), duly attested by the Director/Key Managerial Personnel (KMP) of the Bidder, are mandatory submissions.
11. **CESC's Right to Assess Credibility:** Notwithstanding any of the above clauses, CESC reserves the right to assess the **credibility, capability, and capacity** of the Bidder(s) to perform the contract, should circumstances warrant such an assessment in the overall interest of CESC. Bidders shall furnish all required documents to CESC, as desired from time-to-time.
12. **Purchaser's Right to Seek Additional Information:** The purchaser also reserves the right to seek such additional information as it may deem fit to satisfy itself of the eligibility of the Bidder(s).
13. **Restriction on Participation of Related Parties and Multiple Bids:**
Prohibition of Multiple Bids by Related Parties: No Bidder, or any of its Related Parties (as defined under the Companies Act, 2013), shall be permitted to submit more than one bid, whether individually or as part of a consortium/subsidiary, for the same tender. If it is found that a person



controls (directly or indirectly) multiple entities submitting bids, or is a Related Party to more than one bidder, then all such bids shall be liable for rejection.

For the purposes of this clause:

- The term '**Related Party**' shall have the meaning assigned to it under Section 2(76) of the Companies Act, 2013, including any amendments thereto.
- The term '**Control**' shall have the meaning assigned to it under Section 2(27) of the Companies Act, 2013, including any amendments thereto, which includes the right to appoint a majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions exercisable by a person or persons acting individually or in concert, directly or indirectly, including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements or in any other manner.

Compliance to this provision shall be confirmed by the bidder through **Annexure - V**.

14. The Technical Bid Envelope shall contain the following documents: -

- VI. Copy of Work order issued from the ordering company confirming to quantity mentioned.

15. CESC reserves the right to reject any bid if any or all of these certificates have not been submitted or if the certificate from statutory authorities indicating exemption or non-applicability with regard to any as above has not been submitted. CESC reserves the right to reject any tender or all tenders received at its discretion without assigning any reason whatsoever. **CESC is not bound to accept the lowest offer.**

16. The above details shall be submitted as part of the **Technical Bid in a separate envelope**. The format provided for Technical Bid (Annexure I) shall be filled and enclosed along with Technical Bid. The information provided in this format shall be substantiated with supporting documents which shall be verified by CESC.

C. CONDITIONAL AND INCOMPLETE TENDER

- i. Conditional and incomplete tenders shall be summarily rejected.
- ii. The entire offer to be submitted by the bidder should be unconditional. Any information, assumption, statement having a direct or indirect relation/ correspondence with the quoted rates shall be treated as a condition and as such a deviation from the tender norms stipulated in the tender documents. Bidders are, therefore, requested to thoroughly scrutinize the entire tender document and seek clarifications if required before submission of tender.
- iii. Bidder must fill/quote for all items mentioned in the technical and price bid format with all cells filled-up must be submitted. Non-submission of this sheet and partial quoting will lead to rejection of the bid.



- iv. If any bidder fails to produce any original hard copies of the documents like Completion Certificate or any other documents on demand of the Tender Evaluation Committee within a specified time frame or if any deviation is detected in the hard copies from the submitted copies, it may be treated as submission of false documents by the bidder and CESC may take decision to ban the service provider in participating in future tenders.
- v. **All the submitted documents will have to be attested by the bidder with official seal of the agency / company.**
- vi. The bidder is expected to carefully examine the Bid documents and fully satisfy himself as to all the conditions and matters, which may in any way affect the work or the cost thereof.
- vii. Any document required by CESC in addition to the documents submitted by the bidder shall become the property of CESC and CESC shall have no obligation to return the same to the Bidder for any reason whatsoever.

D. EMD AND SECURITY DEPOSIT

- i. **EMD:** The Bidder shall furnish EMD for an amount of **Rs. 5 Lakh** (Rupees Five lakh only) favoring CESC Limited while participating in the tendering process. The EMD shall be submitted in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay Order drawn in favor of "M/s CESC Limited, payable at Kolkata" and should be **placed in a separate envelope**. Tenders received without EMD will be treated as non-responsive and summarily rejected.
Waiver of EMD deposit will not be entertained.

The submitted DD/amount will be refunded in case the Bidder does not qualify in the Technical and / or Price bid within a period of 7 days. In case the Bidder is awarded the Job Contract and the same is not accepted by the bidder, then this DD/amount will be forfeited. If the bidder is awarded WO and the same is accepted then this DD/amount will be refunded back to the bidder after award of the Work order and receipt of Security Deposit as mentioned in Clause II below.

- ii. **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** For due performance of the contractual obligation, the bidder will have to furnish Bank Guarantee in favor of CESC Limited for **10% of the contract value inclusive of all taxes** from any Nationalized Bank or Private Bank operable in any branch in Kolkata within 7 working days after issuance of 'Letter of Intent'. Bank Guarantee from Co-operative Banks will not be accepted. Validity period of the BG should be till **31.08.2027**. Security Deposit may also be paid by way of DD/Pay-order/Bank Transfer. Bank Transfer should mention "Remittance from towards SD against Letter of Intent no..... Dated". Bank account details is provided in Annexure IV.
The Work Order shall be issued after receiving the Bank Guarantee within the stipulated time.

If security deposit is not submitted within specified time, then the same shall be deducted from the initial running bills.

E. BID OPENING AND FINALIZATION



Bids will be opened at the address mentioned in “General Conditions for submission of Bid” on 28th April, 2026 at 11:00 AM in presence of Bidders or authorized representatives of Bidders who wish to attend the opening of Bids. Only one representative per bidder with proper authorization / power of attorney can participate.
Bid opening may also be carried out through online platform.

The Price bid shall be opened on the date and time, which will be intimated later to the technically qualified bidders.

F. ESTIMATED QUANTITY OF COAL (IN MILLION MT) TO BE SAMPLED PER ANNUM:

• Barabani siding rake sampling	0.9
• Raw coal feed to Washery	1.0

- a) Weight of coal as recorded in the electronic weigh bridge at Barabani Siding shall be considered for billing purpose for sampling of coal at loading end from out-going rakes.
- b) Weight of coal as recorded in the Road weigh bridge at Washery Plant input shall be considered for billing purpose for sampling of coal at washery plant input.

G. CONTRACT PERIOD

Contract Period shall be from **1st Jun, 2026 to 31st May, 2027** which may be extended by one (1) year subject to satisfactory performance by the Bidder on mutual consent.

H. SCOPE OF WORK:

- a) **Rake sampling job at loading end at Barabani Siding**
 1. Collection of samples by manual/mechanical means (as applicable) from railway wagons at loading points for all outgoing rakes as in accordance with the IS 436(Part-1/Section 1)1964 and clause 6.2 of IS 1350 (Part-II)-1970.
 2. Each DNOTE wise Dispatch in a coal rake shall be treated as one lot for the purpose of sampling. The Gross Samples shall be collected in sacks, having inner plastic liner with the mouth of the sacks secured tightly and tagged.
 3. Preparation of samples for laboratory testing for the following parameters: Total Moisture (12.5 mm size), GCV & Proximate analysis (- 212 micron). Preparation has to be carried out as per relevant IS 436-part-I, sec-I, 1964 specification or its latest version.
 4. Room for storage of collected samples and sample preparation shall be provided by ICML at Barabani Siding. Crushing of coal has to be carried out manually.
 5. Carrying out the collection and preparation of coal samples, as stated above, shift wise during the day, throughout the year and carry out daily analysis of the sample drawn. Each shift duration will normally be of 8 hours or as per procedure followed by the generating station. There will be 3 shifts per day.
 6. The above-mentioned tasks and procedures shall have to be executed under competent supervision on round-the-clock (24X7) basis.
 7. All consumables viz. plastic bags, sealing compound and other items required for collection, preparation, storage and analysis of the samples including tools and tackles shall be provided by the bidder.
 8. Samples prepared shall be divided into two equal parts as mentioned:



Set-1: to be retained by the bidder for analysis at their laboratory.

Set-2: to be kept as Referee sample (only for proximate analysis)

9. Testing of sample shall be done in a well-equipped and maintained laboratory for determination of Total Moisture (%), Equilibrated Moisture (%), Volatile Matter (%), Ash (%) and Gross Calorific Value (GCV) of coal (Kcal/kg), of which Volatile Matter (%), Ash (%) and GCV are to be reported as equilibrated on 40^o Celsius and 60% Relative Humidity basis.
10. All procedures should be as per relevant IS – 1350, part-I, 1984 and IS-1350, Part –II, 1970 specification or its latest version.
11. Proper analysis records shall be maintained at the laboratories where the samples are analysed.
12. The procedure adopted, the crucibles used for analysis should be strictly as per IS 1350 Part-I 1984 only. After completion of the analysis, the results are to be submitted to Site management/CESC.
13. The time gap between Sample Collection and Publication of Report on analysis Result must not exceed 7 (seven) working days.
14. Bidder shall abide by all Safety measures related to collection and preparation of sample as laid down by the Station Authority. Necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) has to be provided by Bidder. A penalty up to 5% of the Order value will be applicable for non-compliance to safety norms.

b) Sampling of Raw Coal feed to Sarishatoli Coal Washery Plant

Samples shall be collected from Washery Input Coal Conveyor (BC3) at Sarishatoli Coal Washery Plant as per procedure giving below or as per IS specification: -

1. Total coal input to the Washery Plant per day will be treated as a lot for collection of gross sample. Each Operational day will be 3 shifts of 8 hours each. The sample should be physically collected from Input Coal Conveyor (BC3) at Sarishatoli Coal Washery Plant.
2. Weight of gross sample (1 lot) & number of increments will be as follows:

Weight of Gross sample	Weight of increment	No. of increments
175 kg	5kg	35

3. Samples shall be collected as per the details given below from input Coal Conveyor (BC3). Samples shall be collected as per IS specification.
 - I. Before collecting the increments, the speed of the conveyor and quantity of material passing a certain point in a given time must be ascertained so that appropriate spacing of the increments may be arranged over the entire lot.
 - II. The point of collection of samples from the conveyor can either be at a point where coal discharges from the belt or from the centre and the left and right sides of the moving belt along the same width.
 - III. In case automatic samplers are available for drawing increments from conveyors the setting of such samplers shall be carefully adjusted to ensure that the whole thickness of the stream is taken.
 - IV. The sample will be collected in clean bags and sealed. The bags containing samples will be stored properly in a room till these are processed for preparation of samples.
4. Preparation of samples for laboratory testing for the following parameters: Total Moisture (12.5 mm size), GCV & Proximate analysis (- 212 micron). Preparation has to be carried out as per relevant IS 436-part-I, sec-I, 1964 specification or its latest version.
5. Final sample thus obtained from each gross sample shall be divided into 3 sets and kept in sealed polythene bags.

Set-1: to be retained by the bidder for analysis at their laboratory



Set-2: to be handed over to CESC representative for in house laboratory analysis

Set-3: to be kept as referee sample.

6. Name of the Mine, date of collection etc. should be invariably mentioned on every packet of sample.
7. The Proximate analysis shall be done as per IS 1350 (part I) 1984 and any amendment thereof, on equilibrated basis (60% RH and 40 degree C). Total moisture determination and GCV is to be carried out as per IS 1350 (Part-I) of 1984 and IS 1350 (Part-II) of 1970 respectively.
8. Room for storage of collected samples and sample preparation shall be provided by ICML at Washery Plant. Crushing of coal has to be carried out manually.

I. DOCUMENTATION AND SUBMISSION OF RESULTS

1. Bidder has to document, maintain record and submit Rake-wise daily analysis results of samples tested to CESC in soft up-loadable format as well as in hard print within 7 working days from the date of collection of samples.

2. Information has to be furnished for the parameter mentioned below:

3. Similarly report in designated format to be duly provided has to be submitted for raw coal feed to washery samples.
4. The hard copy of the report containing the above information, duly signed and stamped shall be submitted to Coal Management Division of CESC not later than 7 (Seven) days of loading of the rake, while the soft format of the report to be emailed or uploaded not later than 5 (Five) days of loading of the rake.
5. Monthly statements containing the details of each and every analysis result finalized during a month based on third party analysis, as the case may be, shall be prepared indicating inter-alia the quantity of coal covered by the respective analysis results and shall be applied to the corresponding quality of coal for billing/ commercial purpose. Monthly statement / report duly certified by Bidder shall be submitted to the Coal Management Division of CESC Ltd.

J. STATUTORY OBLIGATION

1. The Bidder shall comply with all statutory provisions in accordance with Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970, ESI Act 1948 and Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952, Minimum Wages Act 1948, Payment of Wages Act 1936, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 which are applicable for the workmen employed by the Bidder.
2. Bidder shall possess valid license from the competent authority according to the provisions as laid down under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and the rules made thereunder as amended from time to time.
3. Bidder shall be responsible for payment of wages and bonus including statutory liabilities, e.g. Provident Fund, ESI, as applicable.
4. In particular, the bidder shall keep CESC indemnified against all claims and disputes arising out of accidents/damages to its workmen & staff, third parties and properties belonging to CESC.
5. The Bidder shall be responsible for any disputes arising out of non-fulfillment of commitments made to its workmen.
6. Necessary Workmen's Compensation Insurance shall be taken out by Bidder accordingly.
7. The Bidder shall be solely responsible for maintenance of records and submission of various forms/ returns prescribed under all applicable State Labour laws and Regulations/Rules viz. in respect of ESI and Provident Fund for the workmen employed by the Bidder. Copies of Bank Challans in respect of Provident Fund deposits every month shall have to be submitted to Station Authority for necessary verification.

K. SUSPENSION OF WORK:

CESC reserves the right to suspend and reinstate execution of the whole or any part of the works without invalidating the provisions of the contract. Orders for suspension or reinstatement of the works shall be issued by CESC to Bidder in writing. The time for completion of the works shall be extended for a period equal to duration of the suspension.

CESC however, shall not be responsible for any liabilities if suspension or delay is due to some default on the part of Bidder or their sub-vendor or any agencies outside the control of the Owner.

L. FORCE MAJUERE:

The bidder shall not be held responsible for non-performance/non-delivery of your services to us due to fire, floods, riots, earthquake or any other acts of God & circumstances beyond your control.

However, In the event that the bidder are affected by a Force Majeure event, you shall forthwith give written notice stating the circumstances of the Force Majeure event thereof to us, together with an estimate in good faith of the degree to which and the period for which your performance may be affected thereby. You shall immediately after cessation of the event of Force Majeure undertake the obligation arising out of the job scope.

M. PAYMENT TERMS :

Bills shall be submitted on monthly basis and Payment will be made within 90 days of submission and acceptance of bills.
